# PGIM INDIA PHOENIX PORTFOLIO

## Focus on companies with high visibility of earnings growth

Dear Investor,

#### PERFORMANCE RECAP

Our portfolio delivered a return of -2.4% vs -6.5% for the Nifty Midcap 100 Index and -8.3% for the Nifty Smallcap 100 Index during June 2022. Our portfolio outperformed the Nifty Midcap 100 Index by 410 bps and the Nifty Smallcap by 590 bps, mainly on account of our overweight stance on Communication, Healthcare and Real Estate sectors. The stocks which outperformed were Inox Leisure, Phoenix Mills, P&G Health, StoveKraft, and Jamna Auto.

On a one-year basis, the portfolio delivered a return of 2.4% vs -1.9% for the Nifty Midcap 100 Index and -13.2% for the Nifty Smallcap 100 Index, outperforming the Midcap index by 4.3% and the Smallcap Index by 10.8%. Our portfolio allocation to small caps is ~58%, hence, performance should be seen in the light of Smallcap Index. The portfolio outperformed the index mostly on stock selection in Communication, Materials as well as Real Estate Sectors and an overweight in the Industrials and IT sectors. The outperformers were Inox Leisure, Phoenix Mills, Jamna Auto, KPIT Technologies and Indian Hotels.

#### **INVESTMENT PROCESS**

In this Investment Approach, we use a judicious mix of Structural and Cyclical companies

**Structural growth:-** India is a developing economy and market. There are a number of unorganized businesses with low penetration. Hence, such companies can only grow by gaining market share from other players and increased consumption once there is affordability and consumers become more aware. Real Estate, Pharmaceuticals, IT companies, etc. have been a part of this theme. We believe some of tomorrow's multi-baggers will be from this space and hence, we have bought these companies with a long-term perspective.

**Cyclical businesses:-** There are many companies in the mid and small cap space which are market leaders in their segments and are profitable but cyclical businesses. For instance, companies in Manufacturing, Finance, Auto Ancillaries, Commodities, Textiles sectors etc. The thought here has been to be invested for a period of 3 to 5 years.

#### PORTFOLIO OUTLOOK

During Q1FY23 results, the key focus would be on management commentary on overall demand environment in the backdrop of elevated inflation, price & interest rate hikes and slowing global growth. Margin and supply side pressures would be other key monitorables.

The high frequency growth indicators for Q1FY23 are robust for India so far:

- Strong manufacturing and services: Average PMI-Manufacturing at 54.4 and PMI-services at 58.4 for Q1FY23 (Apr-Jun'22) are robust. Export growth at 16.77% YoY for Jun'22 and GST collections at Rs 1.45 trn for Jun'22 are also robust.
- Core sector and credit growth improving: Core sector growth in May'22 was 18.1% YoY and non-food credit growth in Jun'22 was 12.6% YoY.
- Southwest monsoon has covered the entire country about a week earlier than the normal date of July 8th, as per the IMD.

We are focusing on companies with visibility of earnings growth with higher certainty equivalent factor and not trading at very high valuations. The domestic story of reforms, relatively strong earnings growth and low debt position of corporate India are the key positives for long-term equity investing. We continue to remain overweight on recovery plays i.e. Consumption, Real Estate, Multiplex and Industrials sector and underweight on Financials. We continue to be positive on the Tata Group which is reflected in our ~18% allocation to stocks belonging to the house of Tatas.

We continue to believe that Investors with a 3-5-year view would benefit from investing in the current scenario.
